## Ordinance No. 53-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK ESTABLISHING A LICENSE FEE FOR JUNKYARDS CONDUCTING BUISNESS IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, it is the village council's intention with this ordinance to set a fee for the issuance of a junkyard license.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, that the following ordinance is hereby adopted:

At the time of submitting an application for a junkyard license and each renewal thereof the person requesting the license shall pay to the Village of Pleak a license fee in the amount of  $\frac{4750.00}{1000}$ . The applicant shall also pay for any and all costs and fees for the services of the Village Engineer for reviewing site plans, drainage plans and any other documents that require the Engineer's review and inspections.

The license shall be valid for one complete year from the date of issuance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and passage.

## APPLICATION FOR JUNKYARD LICENSE TO OPERATE A JUNKYARD WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK

Please provide the following information on separate paper. Each of the following items must be provided for. DO NOT SKIP ANY ITEM.

Payment of all fees must be paid prior to the time that the application and documents are reviewed by the Village Council.

- The full name and mailing address of each owner and operator of the junkyard.
- b. The full name and address of the registered agent for service.
- Whether any owner or operator is an individual, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity.
- d. If any owner or operator is a corporation, provide the names of all officers of the corporation.
- e. If any owner is a partnership, provide the names and addresses of all the partners.
- If any owner is an association, provide the names and addresses of the all
  officers of the association.
- g. The length of time each applicant has resided in the village, the business or occupation pursued by him during the five (5) years immediately preceding the date of such application, giving the place where such business or occupation was followed, whether he is married or single, whether he has ever been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor, including a violation of any city ordinances, and if so the offense and the court in which the conviction was in. If the applicant is a corporation, the application shall contain the same information with respect to each of the following officials: President, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and general manager.
- h. Whether the applicant or the enumerated officers has ever been employed by a junkyard or has ever been engaged in the junkyard business, and if so, the name of the city where the junkyard was located, and the length of time the applicant was engaged in the junkyard business.
- A detail statement of the nature of the business to be conducted, the kind of junk to be collected, bought, sold, stored or otherwise dealt in.

- j. The address where such business is to be located.
- k. A copy of the deed to the land where the business is to be located.
- Attachment of a survey and legal description of the property, and a certified copy of any deed restrictions applicable to the property.
- m. A diagram indicating the location of all buildings being placed on the land where the business is to be located and indicating the location of the fence and the type of fencing to be used, and the type of gate to be constructed.
- n. A site plan to scale, done by a professional engineer.
- A civil drainage plan, done by a professional engineer.
- p. The time periods during which the junkyard will be open for business.
