1. Council to discuss Ordinance 12-72, Animal Limits on Land Ordinance.

The City Council and Planning and Zoning Commission discussed animal limits on Land Ordinance. Many options were discussed but there was no resolution. Ordinance 12-72 has been postponed until more information and legal wording resolved before Ordinance is amended.

2. Council to discuss Emergency Response Readiness for the Village of Pleak.
