## Ordinance No. 38

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK PERTAINING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE OUTDOOR BURNING RULE, FROM TITLE 30 TEXAS ADMINISTRATION CODE SECTIONS 111.201-111.221, AND THE ADOPION OF ANY CURRENT OR FUTURE BURN BANS ENFORCED BY FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Title 30 of the Texas Administration Code, Sections 111.201-111.221, the Outdoor Burning Rules provides rules to protect the environment, promote public health and safety and to avoid nusisance conditions through rules that regulate outdoor burning;

WHEREAS, the Village Council for the Village of Pleak declares that the adoption of the Outdoor Burning Rules established in Title 30 of the Texas Administration Code, Sections 111.201-111.221 would benefit the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Pleak;

WHEREAS, fort Bend County, by and through the County Fire Marshall, is authorized to declare a County wide ban on burning to protect the environment, promote public health and safety and to avoide nuisance conditions;

WHEREAS, the Village Council for the Village of Pleak declares it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Pleak to adopt Fort Bend County's current ban on burning and to adopt any future burning bans that Fort Bend County may enforce.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, TEXAS:

Section A. Adopted.

- That the Village Council for the Village of Pleak adopts Title 30 of the Texas administration Code, Sections 111.201-111.221, the Outdoor Burning Rules.
- That the Village Council for the Village of Pleak adopts Fort Bend County's current ban on burning and adopts any future burning bans enforced by Fort Bend County.

## Section B. Enforcement.

The Fire Chief for the Village of Pleak, or his designee shall have the authority to enforce any and all provisions of this ordinance.

Any person in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars(\$2,000.00).
