## ORDINANCE NO. 46 h we lation or fluture to perform

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, TEXAS ADOPTING VARIOUS 2003 INTERNATIONAL STANDARDIZED CODES.

Section 1. WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village of Pleak, Texas to adopt, in all respects, the various 2003 International Codes;

WHEREAS, the adoption of these codes is done to facilitate proper inspection activities by the Village of Pleak relating to construction and to maintenance of buildings within said Village of Pleak, and relating to public safety, health and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE ALDERMAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, that the following codes are hereby adopted by reference as though they were copied herein fully:

- 2003 International Building Code
- 2003 International Fire Code
- 2003 International Gas Code
- 4 2003 International Mechanical Code
- 5 2003 International Plumbing Code
- 2003 International Property Maintenance Code
- 2003 International Residential Code
- 2003 International Residential Code for One and Two Family Dwellings
- 9. ICC International Electrical Code effective upon its approval and passage
- Section 2: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE ALDERMAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK that any matters in said codes which are contrary to existing ordinances of the Village of Pleak, the codes shall prevail.
- Section 3: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that within said codes, when reference is made to the duties of a certain official named therein, that the designated official of the Village of Pleak who has duties corresponding to those of the named official in said codes shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of said codes are concerned.
- Section 4. Enforcement and penalty.
  - That the designated city inspector for the Village of Pleak or his designee shall have the authority to issue citations for any violation of this ordinance.
  - A violation of any provision of the listed Codes incorporated by reference in this section shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

- 3 Each day of the occurrence of any such violation or failure to perform such act shall constitute a separate offense.
- The imposition of a fine under this ordinance shall not prevent the revocation, suspension or denial of any permit issued or granted by the Village of Pleak, nor shall it be deemed to prevent impede or delay the rights of the Village to proceed in any other court of competent jurisdiction to secure equitable relief, including but not limited to, injunctions or to file suits in the name of the Village or as a member of a class for damages or other relief as provided for by law.
- 5. Any person or corporation who permits, aids, assists or employs another person or corporation in doing any prohibited act or failing to do any act as shall be required in this ordinance shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance, as if such person or corporation had actually committed such act or failed to actually perform such act as herein required.
- In addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, any condition caused or permitted to exist in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be abated by the Village as provided by law.

Section 5. Adoption of ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and passage.
