

## VILLAGE OF PLEAK REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING AUGUST 15, 2018 MINUTES

The Board of Aldermen of the Village of Pleak, Texas met in Regular Session, open to the public, on August 15, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Pleak Village Hall located at 6621 FM 2218 South, Richmond, Texas. Council members present: Mayor Larry Bittner, Wade Goates, Michael John, Damon Kuhn, Carolyn Delmar and Anne Stark. Mayor Larry Bittner opened the meeting with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Council to approve or correct the minutes as presented from the July 18, 2018 City Council Meeting and the August 8, 2018 City Council Workshop.
