Fort Bend County Disaster Recovery Voluntary Buyout Program is a program jointly operated through the Fort Bend County Community Development Department and the Texas General Land Office. The mission is to assist homeowners whose homes were damaged by the 2016 flooding to relocate outside the threat of flooding.

Homeowners who own a property in a Fort Bend County floodway or flood plain may be eligible to receive buyout assistance and will be prioritized.

<u>Current</u> IRS Income Documentation for all residents 18 years and over
Proof of Disability (if applicable)
Proof of Ownership (at the time of the disaster event 2016)
Proof of Primary Residency/Occupancy (Utility bill in the applicant's name at the time
of the disaster event 2016)
Manufactured Housing Unit Documentation (Statement of Ownership if applicable)
Proof of Current Property Taxes or Payment Plan w/List of exemptions (ex:
Homestead Exemption)
FEMA Award/Denial Letter (if applicable)
SBA Award/Denial Letter (if applicable)
Proof of Insurance Claim Payment. Private Insurance Letter (If you did not have
private insurance, a written, signed and dated statement indicating that you had no private
insurance will be acceptable)
Letter of announcement from an "Other" award received for the repair or
replacement of your damaged home, e.g., non-profit, donation grant, etc. (if
applicable)
Copy of receipts, in applicant's name, for the home repairs that have been
made to the damaged property (if applicable).
Child Support Documentation (Affidavit is required for ALL applicants)
Photos of property that tie the damages to the storm (if applicable)
