

## VILLAGE OF PLEAK REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MARCH 18, 2020 MINUTES

The Board of Aldermen of the Village of Pleak, Texas met in Regular Session, open to the public, on March 18, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the Pleak Village Hall located at 6621 FM 2218 South, Richmond, Texas.
