RESOLUTION NO. 20 - 114

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS OR SALVAGE PROPERTY; REPEALING ANY RESOLUTIONS, POLICIES AND PRACTICES, WRITTEN OR ORAL, INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEAK, TEXAS:

- Section 1. The City Council of the Village of Pleak, Texas, hereby finds that a specified ice machine is surplus or salvage property in that the ice machine no longer works and is no longer needed or required for the City's needs.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to dispose of the ice machine by selling it or disposing of it.
- Section 3. The City Council finds that the sale or disposition of the ice machine is for a public purpose.
- Section 4. All resolutions and parts of resolutions, policies, rules, regulations, and practices, written or unwritten, of the Village of Pleak, inconsistent or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the Village of Pleak, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of

the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.
