



**VILLAGE OF PLEAK

The Board of Aldermen of the Village of Pleak, Texas met in Regular Session, open to the public, on January 19, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Pleak Village Hall located at 6621 FM 2218 South, Richmond, Texas. A workshop was set to be held on Wednesday February 2, 2022, at 7pm.


12. Adjournment.
